Worm



The worm is made of wrapped i-cord body with a stocking stitch bump.

You will need:

pink yarn scraps

2 x double ended knitting needles (3mm) • tapestry needle • scissors

Pattern (Body):

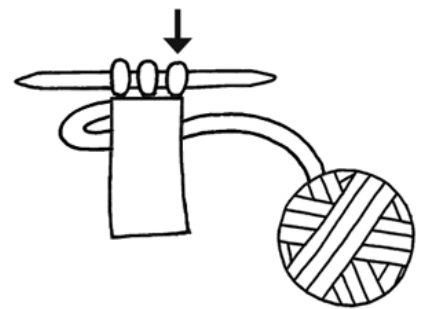


Fig. 1. Take the yarn across the back of the knitting for regular i-cord.

Cast on 3sts and i-cord two rows (Figure 1).

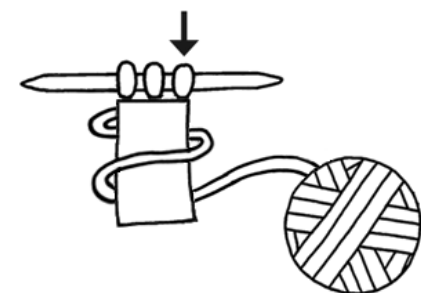


Fig. 2. Wrap the yarn around the knitting clockwise for wrapped i-cord.

Wrap the yarn clockwise around the tube of knitting before i-cording each of the next fourteen rows (Figure 2).

I-cord five rows without wrapping.

Work the wrapped i-cord row seven times.

Cut yarn and thread through remaining sts.

Pattern (Clitellum):

Cast on 4 sts.

Stocking stitch (alternate purl and knit rows) for five rows, starting with a purl row.

Cast off 4 sts.

Making Up:

Wrap the knitted clitellum around the bare patch of i-cord so that the sides almost meet (it is a tight fit). Sew the sides together. Lose any remaining loose ends.

Notes:

Needle/Yarn Size

As with most ODDknit patterns the yarn and needle sizes in the "you will need" section are just a guide. Feel free to improvise with whatever needles and yarn you have lying around – that's half the fun!
